When dentists join Delta Dental's PPO network, they agree to accept established fees for services. On average, **patients save 31.5 percent<sup>1</sup>** on the fee a Delta Dental PPO dentist would typically submit for a claim. In fact, our PPO dentists' rates are often even less than what Delta Dental Premier<sup>®</sup> network dentists have agreed to charge – providing lower out-of-pocket expenses and the best value. Delta Dental PPO network dentists have also agreed **not to balance-bill patients**. That means they can't bill you for the difference between what they usually charge and the amount they've agreed to charge patients with Delta Dental.

Delta Dental PPO network dentists <b>have agreed to charge \$850 for the \$1,200 service, a savings of \$350</b> . Your Delta Dental plan covers <b>50 percent</b> of the cost. Assuming you've already met your deductible for the year, <b>Delta Dental will pay \$425 and you'll pay \$425</b> .	Delta Dental Premier network dentists have <b>agreed to charge \$975 – a savings of \$225</b> compared to the fee the dentist charges non-network patients. Assuming you've met your deductible, <b>Delta Dental will cover 50 percent</b> of that \$975, <b>paying \$487.50. You'll also pay \$487.50</b> . That's an extra <b>\$62.50 tacked on to your share of the bill</b> when compared to what you would have paid with a PPO dentist.	Out-of-network dentists <b>have not agreed to charge a lower fee and can bill the full \$1,200</b> . Delta Dental has set a limit on the accepted amount at \$1,100,* which means <b>Delta Dental's share of the tab is \$550</b> . The dentist can bill you the difference between the maximum allowed fee and what they charge.** This leaves <b>you with a bill of \$650, which includes the \$100 the out-of-network dentist can balance-bill</b> .
